Occupational and Industrial Health is an important branch of medicine that brings together expertise from medicine and several other disciplines. It combines clinical medicine and public health.

Doctors with occupational health background and training have risen to the highest levels in corporate world as well as PSUs and become medical directors of major companies. Occupational Health thus offers an exciting and rewarding career path along with clinical practice possibilities.

This is 3 months full time course regulated by DGFASLI (Directorate General Factory Advice Service & Labour Institutes, Govt. of India). This course will fulfill the requirements in terms of additional qualification for Factory Medical Officers of Hazardous Process Industries as required under the Factories (Amendment) Act, 1987. Other industries also prefer to hire AFIH qualified doctors. This qualification is recognized for appointment as Factory Medical Officer all over India.

Eligibility for admission: MBBS doctors with minimum of 1 year experience in industry or relevant field of occupational health or 2 years' experience otherwise, after completion of compulsory internship. Candidates attached to factories / industries would be given due weightage.

Expert faculty, adequate practical training, in campus hostel, industry exposure and hands-on experience shall be the hallmark of this course. 100% result since inception.

Course fees: Rs. 35000/- for industry / officially sponsored doctors; Concessional fee of Rs. 25,000/- for self-financed candidates. Plus service tax. Other details available on request.
