## Indian Institute of Public Health-Delhi

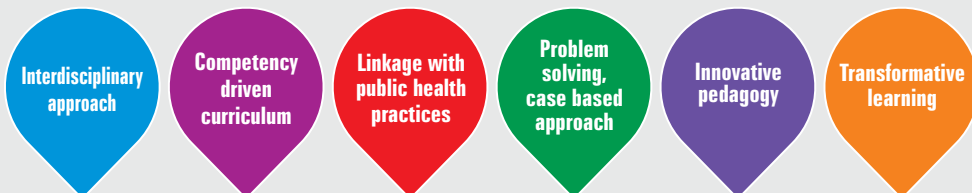

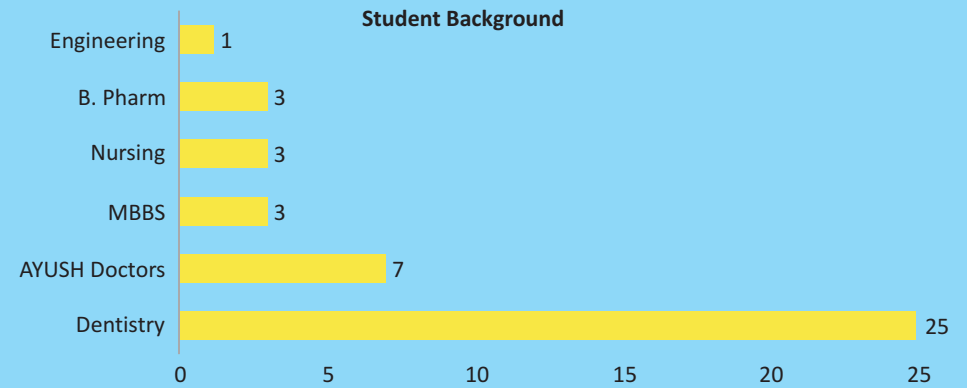

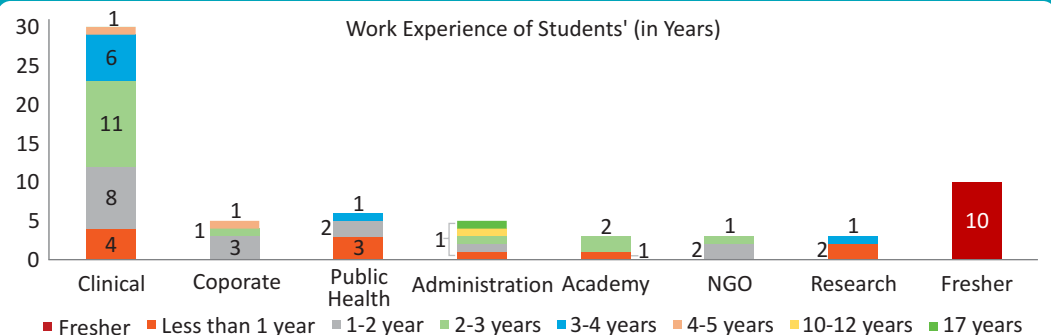
