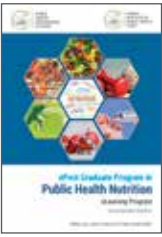

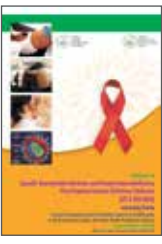

ePost Graduate Programs (One year)

Name of the Programs	Aim
ePost Graduate Program in Public Health Nutrition 	<p>The course aims to provide comprehensive training in public health nutrition in a global setting coupled with an exposure to a number of topics and in a range of contexts.</p>
ePost Graduate Program in Management of Reproductive and Child Health Programmes 	<p>The course aims to develop an in-depth understanding of technical and programmatic issues related to reproductive and child health programmes. It also intends to strengthen the capacity to plan, manage and monitor RCH programmes at the state and district level.</p>
ePost Graduate Program in Epidemiology (only for Indian Nationals) 	<p>The course aims to build a pool of trained public health professionals with a special focus on application of epidemiology in public health.</p>
ePost Graduate Program in Health Economics, Health Care Financing and Policy 	<p>The course aims to increase appreciation of role of health economics, health care financing and policy in public health. It will provide a fundamental understanding of key issues in health economics, health care financing, pharmaceutical economics and economic evaluation for public health practice for informed decision making and implementation.</p>
Executive Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Nutrition-Afghanistan 	<p>The course aims to provide comprehensive training in public health nutrition in the country specific setting including a range of topics.</p>



eCourses (6 months)

Name of the Programs	Aim
eCourse in STI & HIV/AIDS 	<p>The course aims to equip the professionals working in or intending to work with STI and HIV/AIDS prevention, control and/or treatment programs with enhanced knowledge, necessary skills and attitude to provide services, implement programs and conduct training & research in STI and HIV/AIDS.</p>

eLearning Programs

Name of the Programs	Aim
eCourse on Monitoring & Evaluation of Health Programs 	The course aims to strengthen the capacity and update current knowledge about Monitoring & Evaluation of professional working in the field of public health globally.
eCourse on GIS Application in Public Health 	The course aims to provide virtual learning for people working in local enterprise or public sector organisations who require core training and skills development in Geographical Information Systems.
eCourse on Public Health Development for ICDS officials 	The course aims to update current knowledge, strengthen the technical capacity on reproductive and child health nutrition and enhance the managerial skills of the service providers and officials working under the ICDS program.

eCourses (3-4 months)

Name of the Programs	Aim
Certificate Course in Clinical Research Methods for DNB Students 	The course aims is to provide DNB students with a multi-disciplinary perspective to facilitate their skills in clinical research. This course will expose them to fundamental concepts and basic analytic methods to cover topics spanning from conceptualization of research idea to dissemination of research findings to fully equip them to carry out original research and report their findings.
eCourse in Research Ethics 	The course aims to sensitize members of ethics committees, researchers and students on the ethical principles of research ethics in humans, essentially in the context of public health research and implementation trials. The focus of this course would be more related to public health research and implementation research.

Eligibility Criteria*

- Applicants with graduate / post-graduate degree in medicine, AYUSH, dental, nursing, pharmacy, health sciences, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, natural / life sciences, management, social sciences, social work or any equivalent qualification
- Applicants and researchers currently engaged in public health related activities such as health professionals working with directorates of health services, central and state governments, officials engaged in health services at national, state and district level government institutions, or working in health organizations.
- Applicants engaged in health services with National Health Programmes like National Health Mission, Ayushman Bharat, and other national health programs.
