About the course

The Indian Institute of Delhi (IIPHD), Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) is implementing the **Strengthening Primary Health Care And HumAn Resources for Health (SHAHAR)** project aimed at improving the capacities of community-based organizations in Gurgaon.
