POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC HEALTH MANAGEMENT



BACKGROUND

The Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) is pleased to announce its call for applications, for the sixteenth consecutive year, for the Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management being conducted in the academic year 2024-2025 at the Indian Institutes of Public Health, Gandhinagar (Gujarat), Hyderabad (Telangana), Delhi-NCR, Bhubaneswar (Odisha) and Bengaluru (Karnataka).

The public health challenges being faced by the country calls for the development of capacity in the health systems of both the Central and State Governments by way of positioning qualified and skilled professionals who can execute and monitor national health policies and programs, supervise the public health workforce, fully assess the dimensions of public health issues and devise appropriate strategies to meet emerging challenges. The standard MBBS, MD (PSM) and DPH programs offered at medical colleges or the MBA, PG Diploma program offered at business schools do not significantly impart these managerial skills and competencies. Hence, this program is designed to impart the knowledge and skills to address and resolve key health management challenges.

OBJECTIVES

To enhance the capacity of the public health managerial workforce through the conduct and delivery of a specially designed Post Graduate Diploma course in Public Health Management.

COURSE DURATION

The program would be a regular course lasting for nine months of classroom teaching and three months of project work including field study. The total duration of the course is twelve months.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates should have a graduate/postgraduate degree in medicine, AYUSH, dental, nursing, pharmacy, health sciences, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, natural/life sciences, management, social sciences, social work, economics, statistics or any equivalent qualification.

Candidates with work experience in health/development sector will be given preference.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Qualifications	-	30%
Relevant experience	-	30%
Statement of purpose	-	10%
Interview	-	30%
Total	-	100%

Decisions taken by the selection committee will be final.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Eligible candidates would be screened, based on their application and statement of purpose by a specially constituted screening committee. Short-listed candidates would then be interviewed and the final list will be announced. The final selection of the candidate is based on qualifications, relevant experience, statement of purpose and interview.

Reservation of seats in admissions will be as per Government of India policy as applicable from time to time. If suitable candidates are not available under the reserved category, the seats will be filled by general category candidates.

COURSE FOCUS & TEACHING METHODS

This program is interdisciplinary, both in its content and teaching. It utilizes a variety of teaching/ learning techniques, including seminars, journal clubs, collaborative learning, group discussions, case studies, lecture discussions, assignments, hands-on training on computers, visits to organizations of public health interest, practical and field projects. Faculty with diverse disciplinary backgrounds, national and international experience combined with a breadth and depth of public health experience would be teaching this course.

PROJECT WORK / DISSERTATION / INTERNSHIP

Each candidate working under close guidance of a faculty advisor, will develop and work on a project or undertake dissertation or internship. Each candidate will be evaluated concurrently on the study protocol/ work undertaken, while the study is in progress and terminally on his/her report.

COURSE FEES

The fee structure for PGDPHM for self-sponsored candidates in the year 2024-2025 will be as follows:

For Indian and South Asian Nationals:

Tuition Fee

The annual tuition fee for the academic year 2024-2025 is **Rs. 2.4 lakhs** per student.

(which includes Rs. 10,000/- admission fees and Rs. 10,000/- examination fee)

For International Candidates:

Tuition Fee

The annual tuition fee for the academic year 2024-2025 is **7200 USD** per student.
