About the course

The nutrition is in the crossroads of all the sectors: health, agriculture, transport, etc. Nutrition is an input into development. Nutrition has always been considered critical for human and economic development and its neglect would adversely have the impact on health, cognitive development of children, productivity of the people, economic growth of the country and pace of national development. Public Health Nutrition (PHN) is recognized as an educational discipline with the potential to train candidates to not only address nutritional issues but also work in sync with other stakeholders/departments/organizations towards ensuring better health for the masses.

The proposed three-day training programme is a basic level course aims to provide basic understanding of pertinent nutritional issues and related to non-communicable diseases, food systems and diets policies and programmes strategies focusing on addressing non-communicable diseases.
