


ABOUT INDIAN INSTITUTES OF PUBLIC HEALTH (IIPHs)

PHFI is headquartered in Delhi-NCR and its constituent IIPHs set up by PHFI have a presence in Gandhinagar (Gujarat), Hyderabad (Telangana), Delhi-NCR, Bhubaneswar (Odisha) and Shillong (Meghalaya) with an ancillary centre at Bengaluru (Karnataka).

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

PhD PROGRAMS PhD (Science) at IIPH-Delhi

The institute enrols PhD students under the following categories:

- 1. Regular (Full-time)
- 2. Sponsored (Full-time)

Course Duration: Minimum three-year and maximum six-year

No. of Seats: Up to 5 per batch (Based on the availability of the supervisors)

Eligibility:

- Master's degree in Public Health, any stream of Sciences, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM), Social Sciences, Medical and allied fields like Dentistry, AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy), Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Nursing and Veterinary Science, Demography, Nutrition, Social Work, Law, and Business Administration or any other relevant areas
- Good academic record
- Basic computing skills and proficiency in English
- Regular category: Applicants with funding support/ grant/fellowship (minimum residency 3 years)
- Sponsored category: Working professionals with at least two years of job experience (minimum residency 6 months)
- No upper age limit

Selection / Admission:

- Candidates meeting the eligibility criteria will be invited to apply along with a proposed research idea (max 1000 words) and a Statement of Purpose for undertaking a research career (max 300 words)
- Written Exam of short-listed candidates
- Shortlisted candidates after the written exam will be called for an interview

PhD in Public Health and PhD in Hospital Administration at IIPH-Gandhinagar

The institute enrols PhD students for both programs under the following categories:

- 1. Full-Time Research Scholar
- 2. Part-Time Research Scholar

Course Duration:

Full-time Research Scholar: Minimum three-year and maximum six-year Part-time Research Scholar: Minimum four-year and maximum eight-year

No. of Seats: 15 (including both disciplines)

Eligibility:

- 1-year/2-semester Master's degree program after a 4-year/8-semester Bachelor's degree program or a 2-year/4-semester Master's degree program after a 3-year Bachelor's degree program or qualifications declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale
- A candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester Bachelor's degree program should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed

Selection / Admission:

- $\bullet \quad \text{There shall be an Entrance Test (qualifying), and Personal Interview (PI) conducted at the University level} \\$
- The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% research methodology and 50% Public Health for PhD in Public Health. For PhD in Hospital Administration, 50% of the syllabus content would be Hospital Management and Administration specific, apart from 50% Research Methodology.
- Candidates who have secured 50% marks in the Entrance Test shall be eligible to be called for the Interview where candidates are required to discuss their research interests/areas through a presentation
- A weightage of 70% for the entrance test and 30% for the performance in the personal interview/viva voice shall be given and a merit list will be prepared and published on the IIPH-Gandhinagar website

MASTER'S PROGRAMS

Integrated MSc (Clinical Research) & PhD at IIPH-Delhi

Any research that impacts the care and well-being of the human population comes under the domain of clinical research. Clinical research in a broader sense involves epidemiologic studies, clinical trials, translational research, patient-oriented research, behavioural science and, health service research. High-quality data and reliable results are key to generating evidence for decision-making and providing impetus for improving patient care.

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 27

Program Structure:

The course is divided into four semesters over two years. The students who complete the Master's program with a GPA of 8 and above will be eligible for the PhD program. This full-time and project-based PhD program is a minimum of three years.

Eligibility:

- Applicants with graduate qualifications in medical and allied fields like Dentistry, AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy), Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Nursing and Veterinary Science.
- Applicants with graduate qualifications in Biological and Life Sciences (Microbiology, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Botany, Zoology), Basic Sciences (Chemistry), Occupational Therapy and Bio-statistics.
- All applicants should have basic computing skills and proficiency in the English language.

Selection/Admission:

• The applicants will be short-listed based on their academic qualifications, relevant experience and Statement of purpose followed by an interview.

Master of Public Health (MPH)

The public health system in India can be strengthened through the presence of well-trained and competent public health professionals. Qualified public health professionals are a necessity to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals. Such an interdisciplinary public health workforce can also advance the vision of universal healthcare. Our MPH program aims to make public health education and research activities relevant to India in content and context while attaining standards that are qualitatively comparable with the best in the world.

MPH at IIPH-Gandhinagar

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 120

Program Structure:

The course is divided into four semesters over two years. It includes two months of internship and six months of dissertation.

Eligibility:

- Candidates with a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university in India or abroad, with at least 50% marks
- Applicants from diverse academic backgrounds such as medical and paramedical sciences, biological sciences, veterinary sciences, management, social work, engineering, law, commerce, accounting, communication, etc. are eligible to apply.
- Relevant work experience in the health and development sector will be an added advantage

Selection/Admission:

• Selection of candidates is based on past academic performance, screening test scores, professional working experience, and personal interviews

MPH at IIPH-Hyderabad

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 60

Program Structure:

The course is divided into two years, including two months of internship. During the internship, the students undergo two months of field training and submit internship reports. The dissertation is of four months.

Eligibility:

- Bachelor's degree with at least 50% in any discipline from a recognized University by the University Grants Commission and the Degree Awarding University must be a member of the Association of Indian Universities. If the Degree is acquired from Distance Education Mode it must be recognized by the Distance Education Council (DEC) besides being recognized by UGC and AIU
- The percentage will be calculated from the total marks of the 1st, 2nd & 3rd year under the 10+2+3 scheme including languages and other subjects
- Must have secured not less than 40% marks in the Entrance Test. In the case of SC and ST candidates, minimum marks shall be not less than 30% marks

Selection / Admission:

• Master merit list shall be prepared based on marks obtained at the Entrance Test and selections shall be made subject to the government orders issued from time to time and the procedure of reservation prescribed in the regulations for both Competent Authority Quota and Management Quota.

MPH at IIPH-Delhi

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 66

Program Structure:

The course is of four semesters with six months in each semester. The first three semesters include classroom-based, face-to-face teaching, tutorials and practicals. The final semester includes six months of project work (with a dissertation) and two months of internship between semesters or after the completion of the dissertation work, only after formal due permission from their respective supervisors.

Eligibility:

- Applicants with graduate qualifications in Medicine, AYUSH, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy, Veterinary Sciences, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Allied and Health Sciences.
- Applicants with graduate qualifications in Life Sciences, Biotechnology, Statistics, Biostatistics, Management, Engineering, Demography/ Population Studies, Nutrition, Sociology, Demography/ Population Studies, Nutrition, Sociology, Psychology, Anthropology, Social Work, Economics, Law or any equivalent qualifications.
- All applicants should have basic computing skills and proficiency in the English language.

Selection / Admission:

• The applicants will be short-listed based on their academic qualifications, relevant experience and statement of purpose followed by an interview.

MPH at IIPH-Bhubaneswar

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 40

Program Structure:

The course is of four semesters with six months in each semester. The first three semesters include classroom-based, face-to-face teaching, tutorials and practicals. The final semester includes internship cum project work (with a dissertation). The student needs to complete the coursework and the project work to be awarded the MPH degree.

Eligibility:

- Graduation in any stream of medicine (e.g., MBBS/BHMS/BAMS etc.) / Dentistry / Nursing / Pharmacy / Veterinary Sciences / Physiotherapy / Occupational therapy / or Allied Health Sciences
- Graduation in Life Sciences / Biotechnology / Statistics / Biostatistics / Management
- Graduation in Engineering / Demography / Population Studies / Nutrition / Sociology / Psychology / Anthropology / Social Work / Economics / Law or Graduation in any equivalent discipline

Selection / Admission:

• The applicants will be short-listed based on their academic qualifications, relevant experience and statement of purpose followed by an interview.

MPH at IIPH-Shillong

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 40

Program Structure:

The course is divided into four semesters over two years with six months in each semester. It includes two months of internship/dissertation.

Eligibility:

Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university in India or abroad

Selection/Admission:

• The application form is to be submitted along with a 300–350-word personal statement on 'Why I wish to do an MPH' and a 500–750-word essay on a 'Public Health Issue of Relevance to India'.

Master of Hospital Administration (MHA) at IIPH-Gandhinagar

MHA is designed to develop professionally trained administrators who can play an effective managerial role and provide leadership in public and private hospitals and healthcare organizations. To achieve its intended objective, the program curriculum is structured with a multi-disciplinary perspective, including general management and hospital management theories and practices.

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 60

Program Structure:

The course is divided into four semesters over two years with six months in each semester. It includes six months of internship and six months of dissertation.

Eligibility:

- Bachelor's degree in disciplines of medicine & surgery, dentistry, physiotherapy, AYUSH, health & allied paramedical sciences
- Bachelor's degree in nursing including biology, biochemistry, zoology, biotechnology and life sciences from a recognized university in India and abroad
- At least 50% marks
- Relevant work experience in the health and hospital sector will be an advantage but is not mandatory

Selection / Admission:

• Selection of candidates is based on past academic performance, screening test scores, professional working experience, and personal interviews

Master of Public Health-Public Health Nutrition (MPH-PHN) at IIPH-Gandhinagar

This program seeks to produce adept nutrition professionals who can critically analyze, strategize, and lead initiatives that alleviate nutrition-related disparities, promote healthier lifestyles and ultimately enhance the well-being of communities.

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 30

Program Structure:

The course is divided into four semesters over two years with six months in each semester

Eligibility:

- This course is for freshers as well as individuals working in the nutrition sector
- Graduates from medical and paramedical backgrounds including dentistry, Indian Systems of Medicine, graduates in Veterinary/Nursing Sciences, Bachelor of Physiotherapy, Bachelor of Occupational Therapy and Bachelor of Pharmacy
- Students with graduation degrees in basic life science, biotechnology, biochemistry, family and community science, home science (food & nutrition as major subject), dietetics, food science and quality control, food and nutrition, and microbiology

Selection/Admission:

• The selection of candidates is based on academic performance, screening test scores, professional working experience, and personal interviews

Master of Science in Health Economics and Technology Assessment (MSc HETA) at IIPH-Shillong

Course Duration: Two-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 10

Program Structure:

The course is divided into two years and each year consists of two semesters of six months each

Eligibility:

- Bachelor's degrees in Economics, Health and Allied/Life Sciences, Medical graduates (MBBS), Dental graduates (BDS), Graduates of AYUSH (BAMS, BNYS, BUMS, BSMS, BHMS)
- Graduates of four-year degree programs in Veterinary/Nursing Sciences
- Bachelor of Physiotherapy, Bachelor of Occupational Therapy, Bachelor of Pharmacy
- Undergraduate degree in Statistics/Biostatistics, Economics and related disciplines

Selection/Admission:

• The applicants will be short-listed based on their academic qualifications and relevant experience

BACHELOR'S PROGRAM

Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSc PH) at IIPH-Shillong

The B.Sc. PH curriculum has been designed to help students learn about epidemiology, social sciences, environmental health sciences, health policy, health communication, disease outbreak investigation and health education. Students learn to assess a community's health requirements, devise plans/policies, and evaluate & implement health programs.

Course Duration: Three-year, full-time program

No. of Seats: 30

Program Structure:

The course involves three years (six semesters) and an optional fourth year (complete an Honors or an Honors in Research along with a Bachelor of Science in Public Health with Honors / Honors in Research)

Eligibility:

• A two-year secondary level or pre-university examination (10+2) in any stream or its equivalent as recognized by the university

Selection / Admission:

Application forms and other supporting documents are to be submitted online through the admissions portal

POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Post Graduate Diploma Public Health Management (PGDPHM)

(IIPH-Gandhinagar, IIPH-Hyderabad, IIPH-Delhi, IIPH-Bhubaneswar and IIPH-Bengaluru)

Course Duration: One-year, full-time program

No. of Seats:

40 at IIPH-Delhi, IIPH-Hyderabad, IIPH-Bhubaneswar and IIPH Bengaluru Campus 35 at IIPH-Gandhinagar

Program Structure:

Nine months of classroom teaching and three months of project work including field study

Eligibility:

- Graduate/postgraduate degree in medicine, AYUSH, dental, nursing, pharmacy, health sciences, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, natural/life sciences, management, social sciences, social work, economics, statistics or any equivalent qualification
- Candidates with work experience in the health/development sector will be given preference

Selection / Admission:

- The state governments would nominate candidates for the course to the respective institutes as decided by the Government of India
- Self-sponsored candidates applying directly to the institutes
- Shortlisted candidates would be called for a personal/telephonic interview following which offers would be based on a merit list of candidates
