**Public Health Academic Ranking (PHAR), published (March
2024) in the International Journal of Public Health**

Objectives: As there is no ranking designed for schools of Public Health, the aim of this project was to create one.

Methods: To design the Public Health Academic Ranking (PHAR), we used the h-Cites Benchmarking and Analytics™ software and the Web Of Science™ Core Collection database. We collected bibliometric data on 26 schools of Public Health from each continent, between August and September 2022. We included 11 research indicators/scores, covering four criteria (productivity, quality, accessibility for readers, international collaboration), for the period 2017–2021. For the Swiss School of Public Health (SSPH+), a network gathering faculties across different universities, a specific methodology was used, with member-specific research queries.

Results: The five top schools of the PHAR were: London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, Public Health Foundation of India, Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, SSPH+, Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.

Conclusion: The PHAR allows worldwide bibliometric ordering of schools of Public Health. As this is a pilot project, the results must be taken with caution. This article aims to critically discuss its methodology and future improvements.

Over the past decade, **PHFI has established five Indian Institutes of Public Health (IIPHs)** located at Gandhinagar (Gujarat), Hyderabad (Telangana), Delhi-NCR, Bhubaneswar (Odisha), Shillong (Meghalaya) with an ancillary centre at Bengaluru (Karnataka). The Indian Institute of Public Health-Gandhinagar (IIPH-Gandhinagar) was granted University status by a legislative act of Gujarat state in May 2015. These institutes help address the current shortage of trained public health professionals and workers by providing world-class, India-relevant programs in affiliation with renowned universities.

The mission of PHFI and IIPHs is to respond to India's public health challenges, and initiate and catalyse action for better health outcomes. The IIPHs strive to contribute towards the creation of an effective public health workforce in the country. PHFI and its constituent Indian Institutes of Public Health are engaged in program and policy-relevant research, as well as imparting world-class education that is contextualized for the Indian setting. PHFI has also established several Centres of Excellence which work on cutting-edge evidence generation for informing public policy. These centres of excellence and our multidisciplinary team of researchers, with medical and non-medical backgrounds who specialize in technical areas such as health economics, health systems and financing, policy analysis, infectious diseases, chronic diseases, program management, epidemiology, clinical research, genetics, nutrition, biostatistics and demography bring a unique richness to the working environment at the Foundation.

The Indian Institutes of Public Health deliver full-time two-year Master of Public Health (MPH); Master of Hospital Administration (MHA); Integrated MSc (Clinical Research) & PhD; Master of Public Health- Public Health Nutrition (MPH-PHN) Master of Science in Health Economics and Technology Assessment (MSc HETA); three-year Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSc PH); and one-year Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM). An internship/ dissertation of 2-6 months is an important component of each academic program. These programmes are aimed at fresh graduates as well as experienced professionals from medical & allied health sciences, life sciences, and social sciences. The programmes are also attended by mid-level government officials nominated by the various state governments.

These courses are targeted at graduates with diverse background who are interested in public health training at large. The course eligibility criteria reflect the need for multi-disciplinary inputs that are vital to public health. IIPHs have over 55 highly qualified faculty and 79 adjunct faculty with diverse experience. Their expertise is being put to good use in research, teaching and the practice of public health.

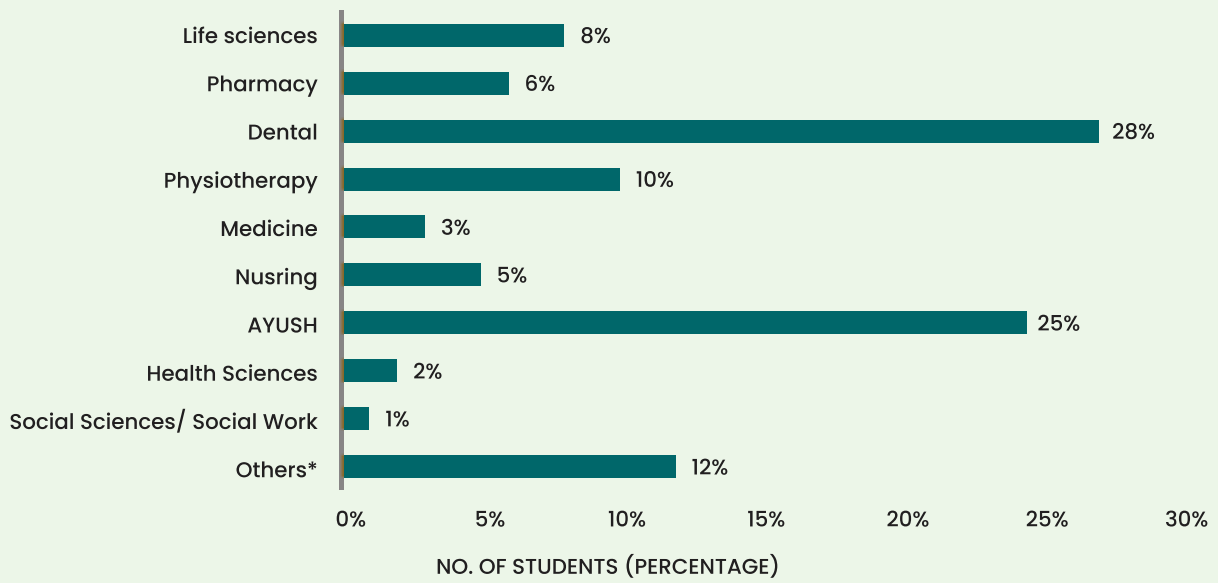

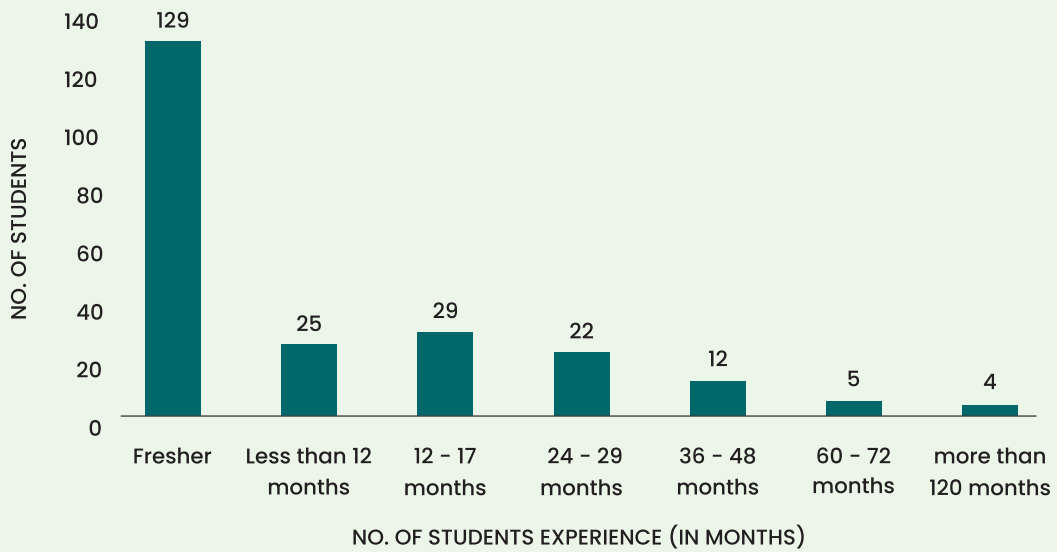
